## What You'll Be Eating at Craft Shack in El Segundo

The Silicon Beach crowd has a new burger option at The Point in El Segundo. **Craft Shack**, a new counter-only concept from **Simmzy's**, opens this week with easy-going bites plus an all South Bay beer list. It's inspired by the kind of beach shack you'd find along the surf and sand, one where you can walk up to the counter to order, get your food, and then find a table or sit in one of the folding chairs. There's even an outdoor shower to complete the look.

The menu is small with a signature burger, sandwiches, salads and a quesadilla "foldover," basically a tortilla filled with caramelized Oaxacan cheese and topped with seasonal veggies that you fold in half to eat. The burger is a simple classic, just an Angus beef patty, American cheese, garlic aioli, lettuce, tomato and onion on a potato bun.

There's a grilled chicken sandwich with guacamole and pepper jack cheese; tacos filled with tuna poke or grilled Oregon rock cod; and a few salads.

Like any good shack, there are myriad fry options, including shoestring, sweet potato or a combo, plus taco fries, shoestrings mothered in cheese, jalapenos and other taco stuff. And a full bar means sipping icy Moscow Mules or tiki-like rum drinks, wine and beers from the South Bay's own 3 Weavers, El Segundo Brewing, Strand, Smog City and The Dudes. To keep it clean, fountain sodas are all non-GMO. Craft Shack opens Monday-Thursday 11 AM-9 PM and Friday through Sunday until 10 PM.
